16:05	<p>New Paphos Marina Site</p> <p>The Paphos Marina is situated very close to a famous area of Coral Bay and is planned to have moorings for 1000 boats, slipways and a boatyard. There will also be further leisure facilities, including restaurants, cafeterias, bars, shops and parking. The new Marina is set to become a focal point for wealthy locals and international tourists and will bring future investment into this already popular area of Cyprus.</p>
16:20	<p>Paphos Town & Harbour</p> <p>The entire town of Paphos is a listed UNESCO world heritage site. Paphos was the capital of Cyprus for a long period of time in antiquity. Today it's a charming town in the west of Cyprus. Numerous archaeological sites can be seen from the centre of the modern town down to its picturesque harbour with its Byzantine fort, as well as along the coast. It is out of the seas of Paphos that Aphrodite the Goddess of Love and Beauty is said to have risen.</p>
