

**AFTERNOON BOAT TRIP TO AKAMAS**

**Description**

Taking a trip into the endless blue of Akamas Peninsula is definitely an experience not to be missed. Our trip will start in the afternoon and will continue through the sunset.

Our starting point will be the fishing outlet located on the waterfront of Coral Beach Resort. Akamas is a wild uninhabited peninsula at the northwest boundary of Cyprus and covers an area of 230 square kilometers.



As the area is relatively inaccessible; there is a large diversity of flora and fauna there. Indeed the European Environment Agency noted that it was one of the only 22 areas of endemism in Europe.

Akamas supports a wide diversity of life including many vulnerable species; some of which are endemic only to Akamas. Wild flowers found there include cyclamen, turban buttercups, alyssum, Cyprus tulip, and many species of orchid, yellow gorse and white rock rose.

As soon as we reach Akamas Peninsula; we will make a prolonged halt. During our stop, we will have the chance to sunbathe on the deck. We will also be able to swim in the crystal clear turquoise waters so that we get a taste of the Cypriot summertime. Later on, the daylight will lend its place to the sunset creating tens of mesmerizing pictures changing from second to second which we will not stop taking photos of.
